Dressing Room Guidelines- Jersey Village High School

Each group will be assigned a private dressing area. Rooms will be assigned according to registration with HTEDance and in consideration of the size of your group. We are asking for your assistance in assuring that your dressing area is clean after the contest. Please understand that many of the dressing areas are classrooms and that the teachers are being gracious in allowing us to use them for this purpose. The following guidelines must be observed in your dressing area:

- No food or drink allowed in the classrooms or inside the building. Most of our classrooms are carpeted. Food and drink are not allowed in the carpeted areas of our school. Please do not bring in any outside food or drink.
- The dressing areas are not secured. Each group is responsible for the care and keeping of all personal and team items. The Jersey Village Gold Dusters, the Gold Dusters Parent Club, and HTEDance cannot be held responsible for lost or damaged items.
- Please "clean and clear" your dressing area to the best of your ability. This involves picking up all discarded bobby pins, safety pins, trash, etc.
- Due to time constraints on the custodial staff, you will need to "clean and clear" your dressing area before awards begin.
- A cleaning fee of \$50.00 will be charged for **each** room that is not considered "clean and clear" by the custodial staff and myself upon final walk through after the contest. It is imperative that all rooms be left in good condition so that I may continue to offer the private dressing areas to our participants.
- Absolutely no men are allowed in dressing room areas or hallways.
- If you have a male on your team, they will be given a separate dressing room. Please communicate that with me at ryan.garcia@cfisd.net before you arrive at contest.

I greatly appreciate your cooperation with the above guidelines. I believe we can all agree that it is more convenient to have your own dressing area rather than having to share with several other teams.
